Budapest, Bratislava, Vienna, Wachau, Salzburg, Linz...

City and culture Nature and landscapes

- Lots of history and options in one voyage. The 19th century left its mark on these cities, and the present has revitalized them. Bratislava first, then grandiose Budapest, and the highlight of the trip, the stateliness of Vienna.
- And time and again, the overwhelming landscapes on both shores. The Wachau Valley, with its romantic scenery fit for lovers, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A new surprise awaits behind every bend.
- Guided by experts, you'll discover the culture, history and present of the ancient cities of Vienna, Budapest and Bratislava..

DAY 1. BUDAPEST

Arrival, assistance at airport and transfer to hotel. Free time. Lodging.

DAY 2. BUDAPEST

Transfer to the port to board the A-Rosa RIVA, where ladies will be greeted with a rose. Lodging. Free time. Welcome drink and dinner buffet. Night onboard.

DAY 3. BUDAPEST

All meals onboard included. After the breakfast buffet, we'll start the tour (included) of this beautiful city bathed by the Danube, a marvel for the senses, where we can admire the Parliament, the Opera, St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Castle and more. Return to the ship for lunch buffet. Afternoon free. If you want, you can join us on a nighttime visit to Budapest (optional) and take in the lights, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, and we'll finish the tour by taking in a folk show.

DAY 4. BUDAPEST-ESZTERGOM

All meals onboard included. Morning free so you can continue enjoying this city. After lunch, we will visit the Danube Bend (included), which includes a tour of St. Andrew, a town of artisans, a panoramic view of Visegrad, and a tour of the impressive Esztergom cathedral. Lodging and buffet dinner onboard.

DAY 5. BRATISLAVA-VIENNA

All meals onboard included. When you wake up we will be moored in Bratislava, the capital of Slovakia. Walking tour of the city The Danube River provides a stark contrast between the old and new parts of the city. To the north are the picturesque streets of the old quarter, the Stare Mesto, with interesting landmarks that we'll see on our tour, like the St. Martin Cathedral, the Tower of St. Michael and the Primate's Palace. The river's banks are joined by the huge Novy Most Bridge, atop which sits a restaurant that offers incredible views of the city and of the Carpathian Mountains in the distance. Lunch onboard. Pleasant afternoon of sailing so you can enjoy the magnificent facilities onboard the Arosa RIVA, and perhaps have a nice beer on the sunning deck. At approximately 20:00 we will arrive in the city of Vienna.

DAY 6. VIENNA

All meals onboard included. After a breakfast buffet, we'll start the guided tour of the old capital of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Bathed by the Danube, Vienna is a delight for the senses. On our tour we'll see Hofburg Palace, Belvedere Palace, the Votive Church, the Cathedral of St. Stephen and more. There is also

is an optional visit to Schonbrunn Palace, the former summer residence of the emperors, and which was home to famous characters like Franz Joseph and Sisi. Return to the ship for lunch. Free time. In the evening, there's the possibility of attending a classical music concert in an incomparable venue like the Palais Auersperg, with pieces by Mozart and Strauss. Night onboard.

DAY 7. DURNSTEIN-WACHAU VALLEY-MELK

All meals onboard included. At 08:00, we arrive in Durnstein. Walking tour of this typical village in the area, famous for having imprisoned Richard the Lionheart in its castle. Return to the ship for lunch. Sail through the Wachau Valley, one of most beautiful areas bathed by the Danube. At 16:00 we'll dock in Melk, where you'll be able to visit the famous Melk Abbey. Baroque ecstasy in the Danube Valley (optional). Like something out of a Romantic painting or a backdrop on a stage, the Abbey juts out above a scraggly rock, one of the most beautiful examples of Baroque architecture in Austria. Return to the ship for dinner and lodging.

DAY 8. LINZ: SALZBURG

All meals onboard included. When you wake up, we'll be moored in Linz, the capital of Upper Austria. As indicated

by the nickname used for many years, "Linz an der Donau", the city hugs the shores of the Danube like few other cities in Austria. We offer an optional excursion to Salzburg, a city that is famous worldwide due to the incomparable magic of the city's outline, the beauty of the surrounding landscape and the city's most famous native, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. Lodging onboard.

DAY 9. LINZ-VIENNA

Breakfast buffet. Disembark, group transfer to the Vienna airport. End of trip and our services.
